

Conditions of entry

1. The competition will be swum under A.S.A. Laws and Technical rules and licensed by the ASA for entry into National Competitions.
2. Age groups are single years with the following events. 9-11B & 9 -10G 50m swims.100m's for girls 11+ & Boys 12+, 200 free & medley & 50 free for all ages. Ages as at 04<sup>th</sup> Oct (day of the meet)
3. All events will be run on a heat declared winner (HDW) basis. The last heat in each event will be spearheaded. **25m entry times should be submitted.**
4. All entries are subject to being within the qualifying times.
5. Speeding tickets may be issued to swimmers that swim faster than the cut off times. They will be allowed 1 sec per 100m above those times.
6. Entries to be accepted on a '**First come first served**' basis.
7. **No Time Trials will be held.** Any empty lanes may be filled by Crawley swimmers.
8. Awards will be given in single age groups to (15+G & 16+B) placed 1<sup>st</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> without disqualification. These awards can be collected from the awards table poolside.
9. Entry fee is £4 for 50m & 100m and £5 for 200m events. Entries will be via email on the Hy-tek software available from the Crawley website. Entries not via Hytek will incur a £5 admin fee. Entries must be sent by club with a single club cheque, Coach passes are £10 which will entitle the holder to admission to all sessions, a program and poolside refreshments (not food). Passes must be displayed at all times.
10. All meet participants and spectators must observe all safety precautions in operation at K2 Crawley Leisure Centre and follow the instructions of pool staff.
11. Swimmers must not go up to the balcony without first drying off and putting on footwear and clothing before leaving the poolside.
12. Competitors are advised not to leave their belongings unattended and to ensure that all valuables are placed in a locked locker (a returnable £1 coin). Neither Crawley Swimming club nor K2 Crawley Leisure Centre can accept responsibility for any property that may be lost or stolen.
13. Video recording /Photography / Mobile phones. In accordance with the recommendations of the ASA child protection policy, any person wishing to use video, zoom or close range photography, including mobile phones that have photographic capabilities should first register their details at the spectator entrance. It is requested that all mobile phones are switched off or to silent during the competition and that there is no flash photography at the start of each event.
14. Data protection with the submission of entries. Consent is deemed to have been given, as required of the data protection act, to the holding and distribution as necessary, of personal information on computer, to run the meet.
15. The promoters reserve the right to close the meet when the scheduled events are fully filled.
16. Closing date for last entries is **10th Sept 2009**. Only if not already full.
