Basingstoke Bluefins SC is pleased to present its 8th Annual Graded Open Meet, to be held on Saturday 3rd April 2010 at the Aquadrome Pool in Basingstoke. This is Easter Saturday, so this is an Easter Egg meet. All winners will receive an Easter Egg in addition to their medal.

At Easter time there are lots of high level Licensed Open Meets aimed at swimmers trying to get qualifying times for the National Championships. Our meet is different. We are providing a friendly event for everyone else. In fact, if anyone beats the Hampshire County Qualifying time, we will award them a speeding ticket, but not a medal. There are two sessions, each aimed at a different age group, so swimmers should not have to wait around all day.

Basingstoke Bluefins Swimming Club will be holding their annual Easter Egg Graded Open Meet on Saturday April 3rd 2010 at The Aquadrome, Basingstoke. Electronic timing will be used. There will be two sessions:

Session	Age Group	Warm-up	Withdrawal
Afternoon	10/Under, 11	12:15pm	12:30pm

- All swimmers must be 9 years of age on or before 3rd April 2010. **All ages are as at midnight on 3rd April 2010.**
- All age groups in each session will compete together, seeded according to entry time. Swimmers with no entry time will swim first, youngest first.
- This is a graded gala. Any swimmer recording a time faster than the grade time below will receive a speeding ticket and will not be eligible for a medal. [Entries with time faster than the grade time will be accepted if there is space available.]
- Medals will be awarded to the first three swimmers in each age group. In addition, the winners will receive an Easter Egg.
- Results will be determined according to heat times; there will not be finals.
- Over the top starts will be used (except for backstroke events).
- A withdrawal system will be in operation. Coaches are asked to withdraw swimmers who are not competing no later than 15 minutes after the published start of warm-up.

- The entry fee is £4 per event (or £14 for all 4 events). **It is not necessary to include an SAE.**
- Entries should be sent to **Mr. M. Lambert, 79 Camrose Way, Basingstoke, RG21 3AW**, together with the appropriate entry fee. Cheques should be made out to **Basingstoke Bluefins**. Photocopies of the entry form are acceptable. Multiple entries may be made on the same form. **Entries may also be made via the Basingstoke Bluefins WEB site www.swimbluefins.org**
- The closing date for entries is **Monday 15th March 2010**. Late entries may be considered at the discretion of the promoter if the event is under-subscribed.

If the event is over-subscribed, entries will be accepted on the following basis:

- Incomplete or incorrect entries will be rejected
- Preference will be given to swimmers competing in 3 or more events
- Entries will be accepted on a first-come first-served basis

Confirmation of accepted entries will be sent directly to the swimmer concerned. A list of accepted entries will be displayed on the Basingstoke Bluefins Web site www.swimbluefins.org
